

How to use the user favourites block



User Favourites is a feature that lets you bookmark or "favourite" any page or activity in the portal so you can quickly access it later.


- Here's what it does:
- Save shortcuts You can click "Favourite this page" to save the current page (e.g., an assignment, forum, quiz, or course page) into your personal list.
- Quick access Your saved favourites appear in the User Favourites block, so you
 can jump straight to them without navigating through the site.
- Custom titles You can rename each favourite to something more meaningful to you.
- Reorder and manage You can drag to reorder your favourites or delete ones you
 no longer need.
- Personal to you

Phase 1 How to add the 'User Favourites' block to your dashboard


Step 1 Kindly log in to the portal.




Once logged in, you may click to open the block drawer on the right side of your dashboard.




Locate the 'User Favourites' block. If it does not appear in the Block drawer, follow the steps below to add it. If the block is already visible, you may skip the steps for adding the 'User Favourites' block.




Step 4 Turn on 'Edit mode' and click the 'Add a block'.



Step 5 Once you click the 'Add a block' button, the Add a Block menu will appear. Then, click on 'Moodle Blocks'.




Scroll down until you find the 'User Favourites' block and click on it. You can then check the block drawer to see the newly added block.




Phase 2 How to use the user favourites block

Click on the 'User Favourites' block. When you're on a page you want to save, just click "Favourite this page" in the block.




Step 2 After clicking "Favourite this page," a block will appear where you can set a custom title for your favourite. Then click 'Save'




Once you click Save, the Page that you favourited will appear under the 'User Favourite' block.


Tip: You can add any page or activity to your favourites, such as assignments, forums, or other pages that are important for you.




You can edit, delete, and customise the arrangement of your favourites by clicking the icon below and dragging to reorder them, or by clicking 'Delete Favourite' to remove a link.



You can drag the 'User Favourites' block to your dashboard by turning on Edit mode and clicking the move icon to place the block where you want it on your dashboard.



Step 6 You will now see the block displayed on your dashboard.
