#### **CONTENT SYNOPSIS:**

This module has 3 basic streams, women and child health and elderly health. Women's health gives an introduction to principles of reproductive health. It includes the basic programmes of reproductive health such as safe motherhood and high-risk approach in MCH care.

It will also include STD/HIV and common cancers seen among women. The child health component will provide the basic concepts of child health, including growth and development, immunization and breast-feeding and the common diseases of children. Topic will include perinatal care, fetal growth factors.

Communicable diseases such as ARI and CDD will also be included. Adolescent and elderly health care discusses common health problems among these vulnerable groups. Nutrition in the life cycle and school health are highlighted. The learning is further enhances by field visits and seminars.
